- Limited access to transportation, pharmacy, housing, and other resources after 5p and on weekends
- Must become creative when assisting with discharge planning
- No pool of \$\$\$ to pull from
- CVMC uninsured and Medicaid population make up over 35% of our volume
- Sylacauga has poverty level of 26.9% compared to national level of 13.4%
